Mission Statement

With the clear goal of purchasing Mighty Mangaroo with the intent to train and develop him through the three and four star levels of eventing, the plan is to syndicate the horse with Laura VanderVliet as the rider.

Terms

Number of shares: Ten

Cost per share: \$10,000

Annual Maintenance: \$30,000 (\$3,000 per share – tax deductible)

Basic Agreement

- 1.) This is a non-profit focused syndicate, motivated to develop horse's progress to the highest level of competition.
- 2.) Prize money will first be used to subsidize additional maintenance costs of competing Mighty Mangaroo. Subsequent savings can reduce monthly contributions or be reimbursed equally between shareholders.
- 3.) Ten shares are available at \$10,000 per share. An individual may purchase more than one share or portion of shares. Monthly maintenance costs are tax-deductible through the American Horse Trials Foundation.
- 4.) Buy out, rider or horse injury and dissolution contingency plans will be provided for in the syndicate agreement.

Benefit

In return, we are offering part-ownership of a very talented and valuable young event horse, VIP hospitality at top-level competitions, and the rare but exciting opportunity to be involved in the development of a horse and rider partnership with the potential to compete at national and international levels and possibly represent the United States in team competition.

Member Perks

Owners will be provided with a complete competition schedule and events surrounding specific competitions. Assistance with travel plans and accommodations can be provided. Each owner will be provided with VIP parking access to VIP Owner and Sponsor functions at events offering them. Additional benefits can include coursewalks with Laura at events, up to date results and behind the scenes access to stabling and training sessions.

Tax Exempt Opportunities

Annual maintenance costs can be 100% tax deductible according to IRS Code Section 501(c)(3). Riders who are bona fide national or international level competitors are eligible to apply for grants from the American Horse Trials Foundation. These grants can support the cost of board, training, competitions, veterinary care and insurance. Laura has been granted eligibility. She is currently a long-listed event rider for team competition and is included on the USEF high performance list of riders.
